## Rear Disk Guard Installation

- 1. Remove rear wheel
- 2. Remove brake pads from caliber
- 3. Remove caliber from stock brake caliber (11mm wrench).
- 4. Remove rubber boot from caliber guide pin
- 5. Remove brake pad wear plate from stock carrier (fig 1)
- 6. Install rubber guide boot and carrier wear plate into new disk guard (fig 2)
- 7. Install brake caliber to disk guard (use Loctite on bolt).
- 8. Re-install brake pads and rear wheel




